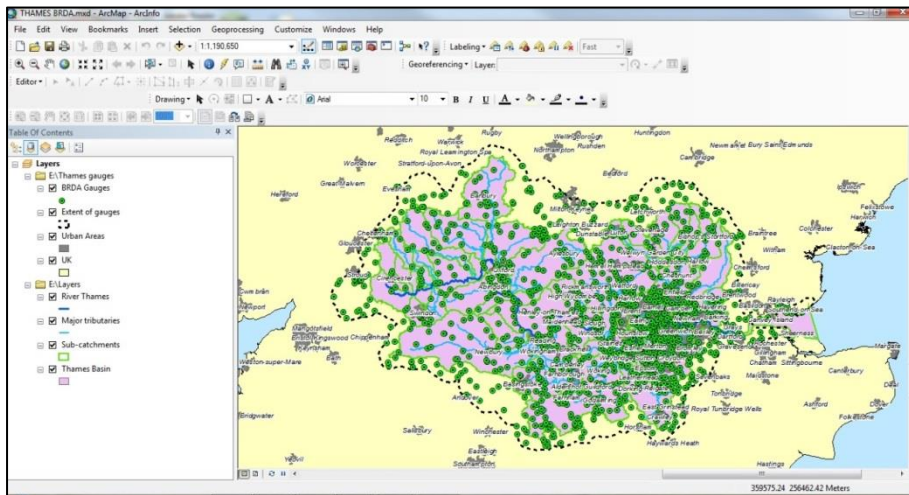


British Rainfall Digital Archive GIS Link

The British Rainfall Digital Archive (BRDA) is an archive of extreme UK rainfall compiled by **Hydro-GIS Ltd** with data extending back until 1866 including:

- Over 28,000 measurements of extreme rainfall observations
- Over 1000 pages of observer accounts including a summary of the weather conditions, ensuing floods and damage
- Over 250 maps and photographs



A GIS link for the Thames Basin has been developed in ArcGIS and enables a spatial search of the archive to access data within an internet explorer interface. The full BRDA for the whole of the UK can be accessed through this interface. The link is a free standing system run through a CD, which requires ArcGIS Version 9.0 (or later) and Internet Explorer.
